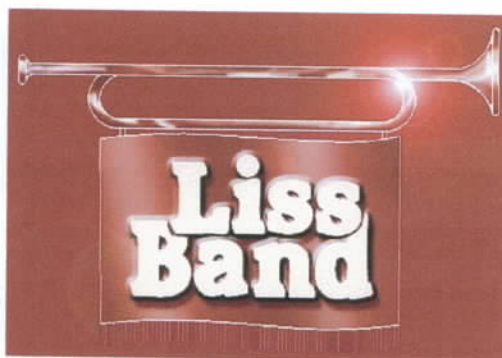

## Cassette & CD Available

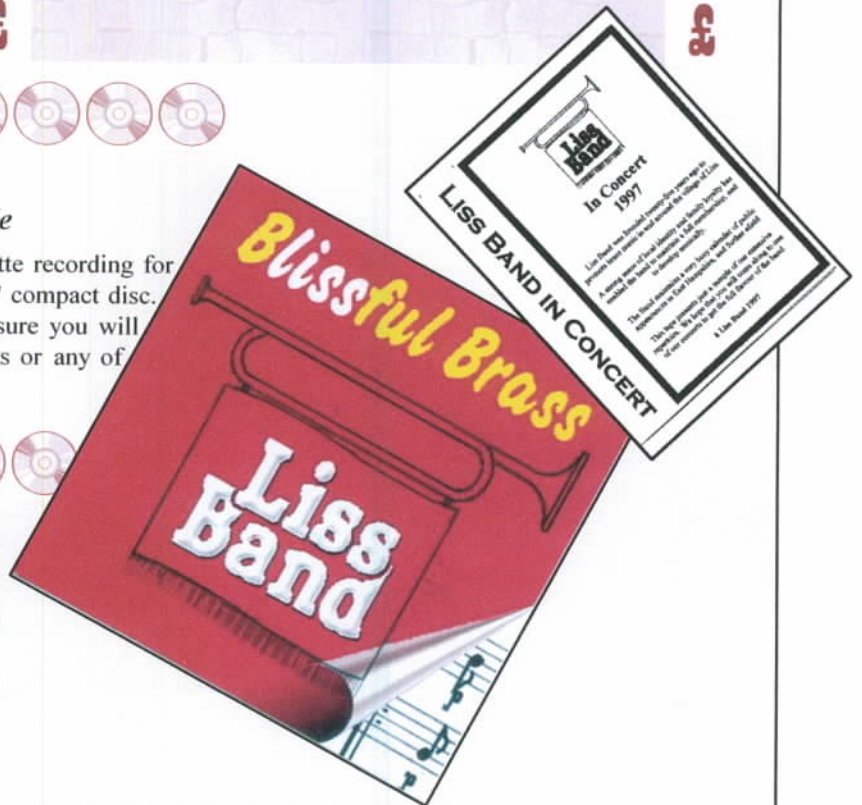
